Group Play

This age group will consist of 22 teams total and will be broken down into 4 groups of four (A through D), and a group of 6 (E1 and E2). Each group of 4 will play each other within their group, the group of 6 will play a modified cross-over bracket format (each team in their group, then E1 #1 vs. E2 #3, E1 #2 vs. E2 #2, E1 #3 vs. E2 #1)

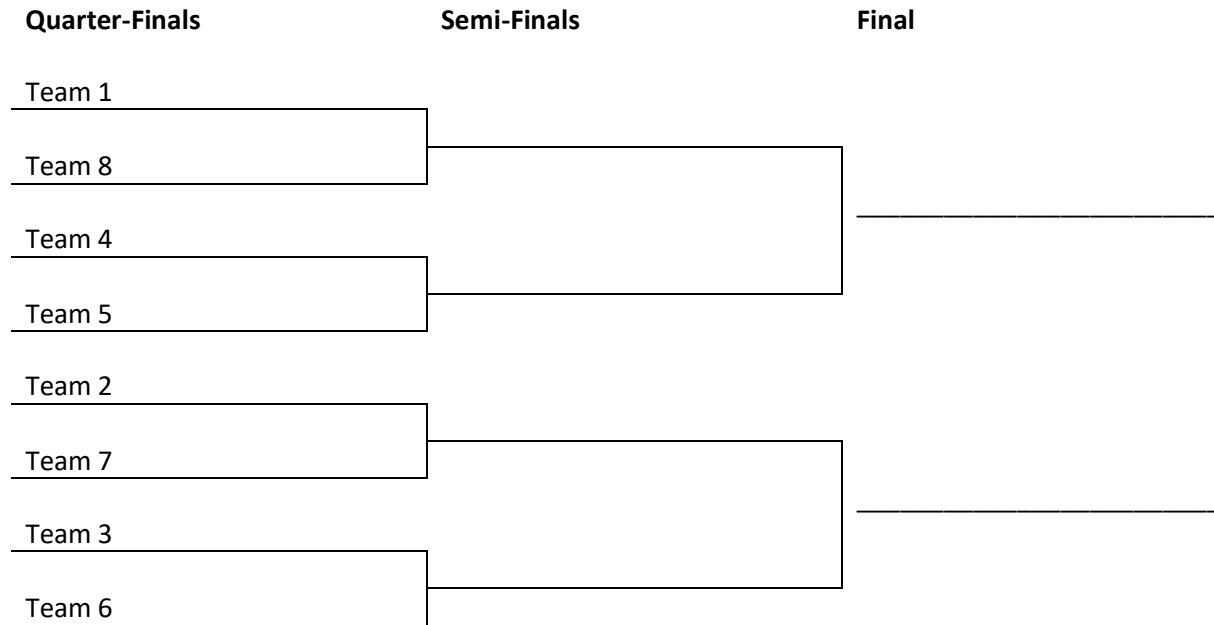
Advancement

This age group will advance to three groups: **SuperCopa**, consisting of the six group winners and the two highest ranking Wild Card teams, following normal SuperCopa advancement protocols; **Gold**, consisting of the next eight highest ranking Wild Card teams; and **Silver**, consisting of the next six highest ranking Wild Card teams.

Knock Out Rounds

SuperCopa, and **Gold** will play Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals. Quarter-Finals will be seeded 1 v 8, 2 v 7, 3 v 6, 4 v 5, following normal SuperCopa seeding protocols. There is no reseeding after Quarter-Finals. **Silver** will play Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals. For the Quarter-Finals, Teams 1 and 2 will receive a bye into the semi-finals and teams 3 through 6 will play. Quarter-finals will be seeded 3 v 6 (advancing to play 2 in the semi-finals) and 4 v 5 (advancing to play 1 in the semi-finals).

U10 Boys

Group Play

This age group will consist of 40 teams total and will be broken down into ten groups of four. Each group will play each other within their group.

Advancement

This age group will advance to five groups: **SuperCopa**, consisting of the ten group winners and follow normal SuperCopa advancement protocols seeding for within the group; **Gold**, consisting of the six highest ranking Wild Card teams, following normal SuperCopa advancement protocols; **Silver**, consisting of the next eight highest ranking Wild Card teams; **Bronze 1**, consisting of the next eight highest ranking Wild Card teams; and **Bronze 2**, consisting of the next eight highest ranking Wild Card teams.

Knock Out Rounds

SuperCopa, will play a first-round, Quarterfinals, Semi-Finals and Finals. First-round games will be played by Teams 8 and 9 to advance to the Quarterfinals to play Team 1 and by Teams 7 and 10 to advance to the Quarterfinals to play Team 2. The losers of the first-round games will be placed into the **Gold** bracket and compete as the two highest seeds, as determined by their seed number in the **SuperCopa** group. The remainder **SuperCopa** Quarterfinals will be seeded 4 v 5 and 3 v 6. All this seeding follows normal SuperCopa seeding protocols. **Gold** will receive the two losing teams from the **SuperCopa** first-round games to play seeds 7 and 8, **Gold** Quarterfinals will be seeded 1 v 8, 2 v 7, 3 v 6, 4 v 5, following normal SuperCopa seeding protocols. **Silver, Bronze 1, and Bronze 2** will play Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals. Quarterfinals will be seeded 1 v 8, 2 v 7, 3 v 6, 4 v 5, following normal SuperCopa seeding protocols. There is no reseeding after Quarterfinals.

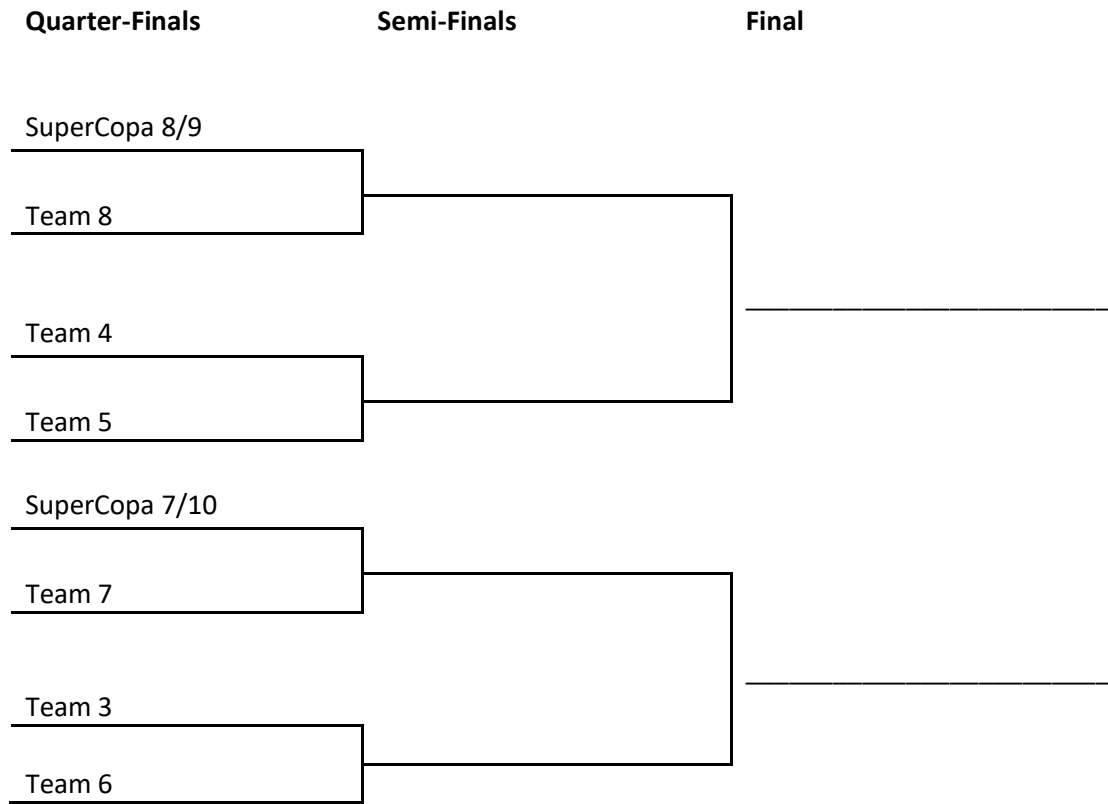

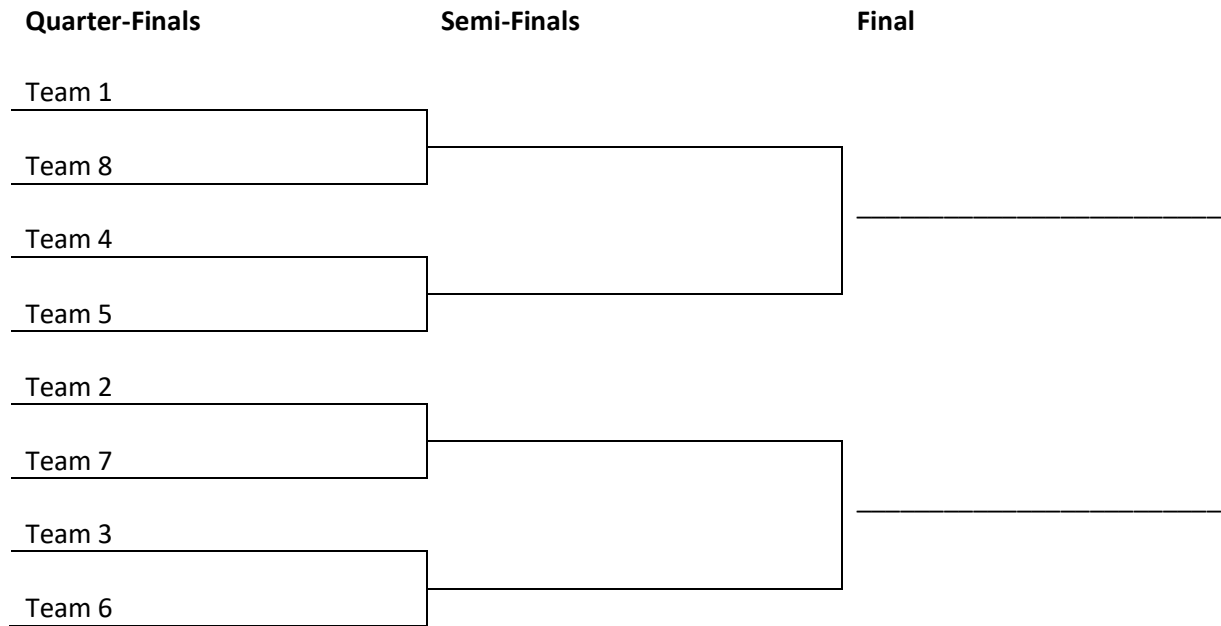

Group Play

This age group will consist of 40 teams total and will be broken down into ten groups of four. Each group will play each other within their group.

Advancement

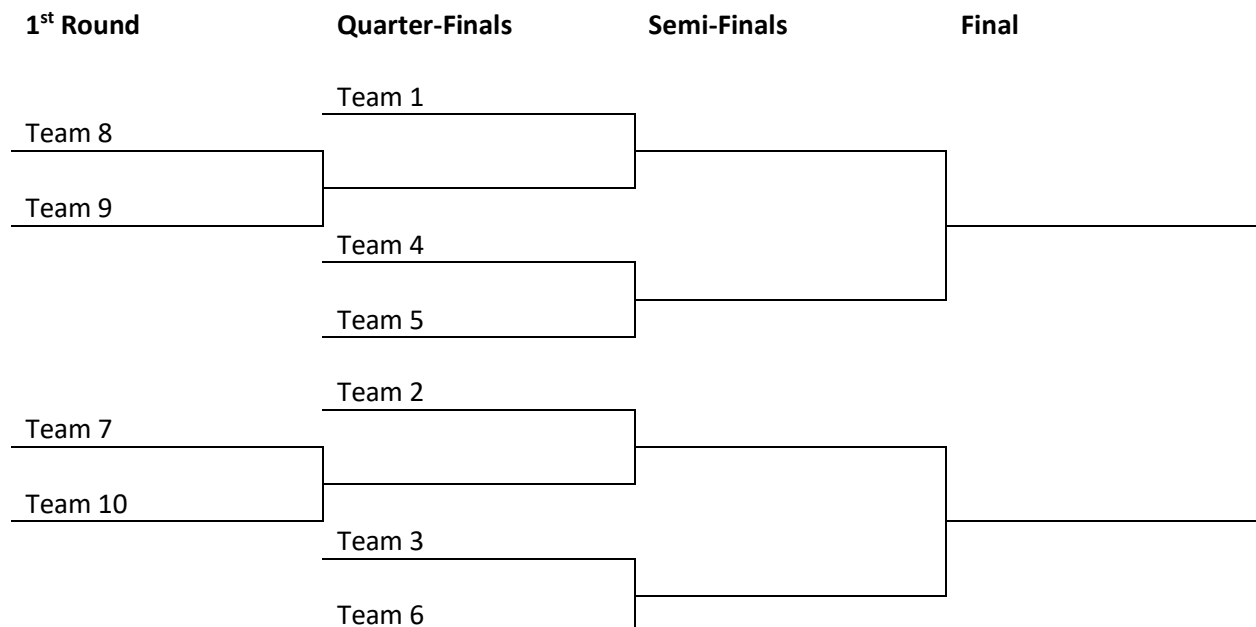
This age group will advance to five groups: **SuperCopa**, consisting of the ten group winners and follow normal SuperCopa advancement protocols seeding for within the group; **Gold**, consisting of the six highest ranking Wild Card teams, following normal SuperCopa advancement protocols; **Silver**, consisting of the next eight highest ranking Wild Card teams; **Bronze 1**, consisting of the next eight highest ranking Wild Card teams; and **Bronze 2**, consisting of the next eight highest ranking Wild Card teams.

Knock Out Rounds

SuperCopa, will play a first-round, Quarterfinals, Semi-Finals and Finals. First-round games will be played by Teams 8 and 9 to advance to the Quarterfinals to play Team 1 and by Teams 7 and 10 to advance to the Quarterfinals to play Team 2. The losers of the first-round games will be placed into the **Gold** bracket and compete as the two highest seeds, as determined by their seed number in the **SuperCopa** group. The remainder **SuperCopa** Quarterfinals will be seeded 4 v 5 and 3 v 6. All this seeding follows normal SuperCopa seeding protocols. **Gold** will receive the two losing teams from the **SuperCopa** first-round games to play seeds 7 and 8, **Gold** Quarterfinals will be seeded 1 v 8, 2 v 7, 3 v 6, 4 v 5, following normal SuperCopa seeding protocols. **Silver, Bronze 1, and Bronze 2** will play Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals. Quarterfinals will be seeded 1 v 8, 2 v 7, 3 v 6, 4 v 5, following normal SuperCopa seeding protocols. There is no reseeding after Quarterfinals.

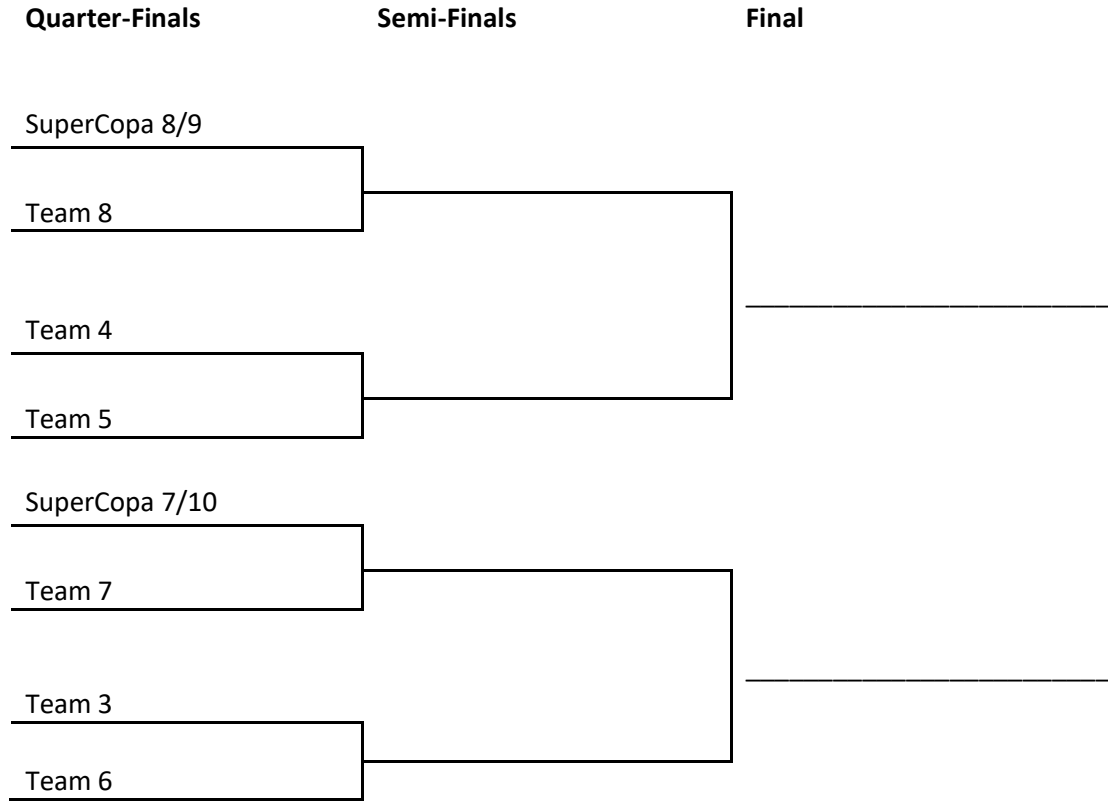

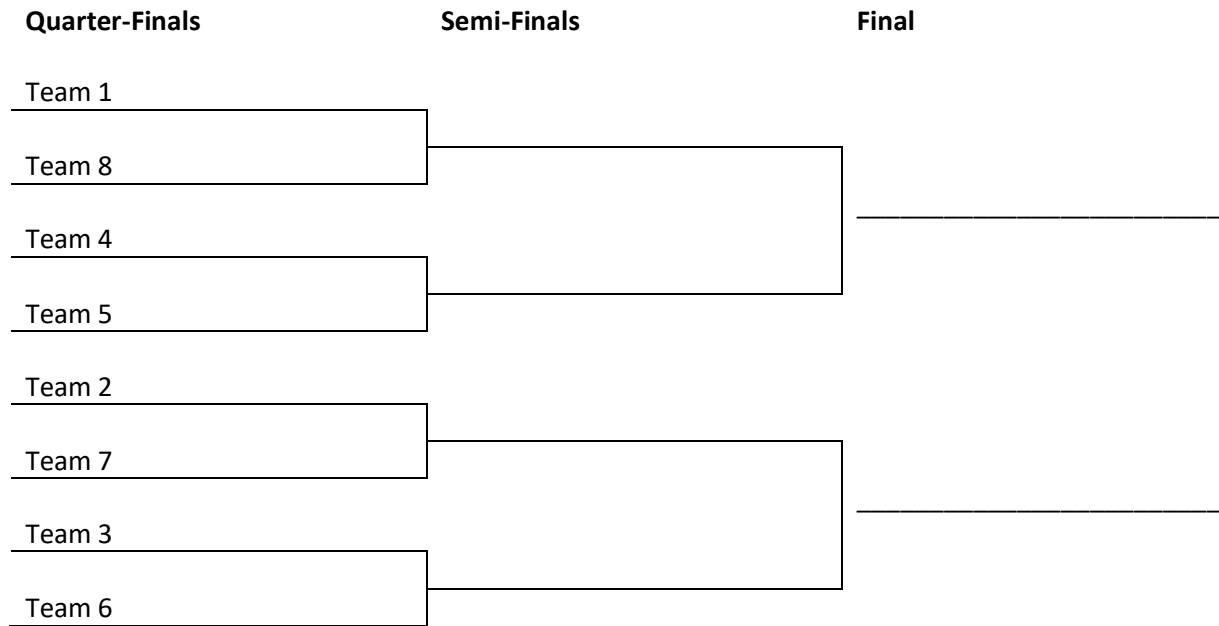

This age group will consist of 24 teams total and will be broken down into 6 groups of four. Each group will play each other within their group.

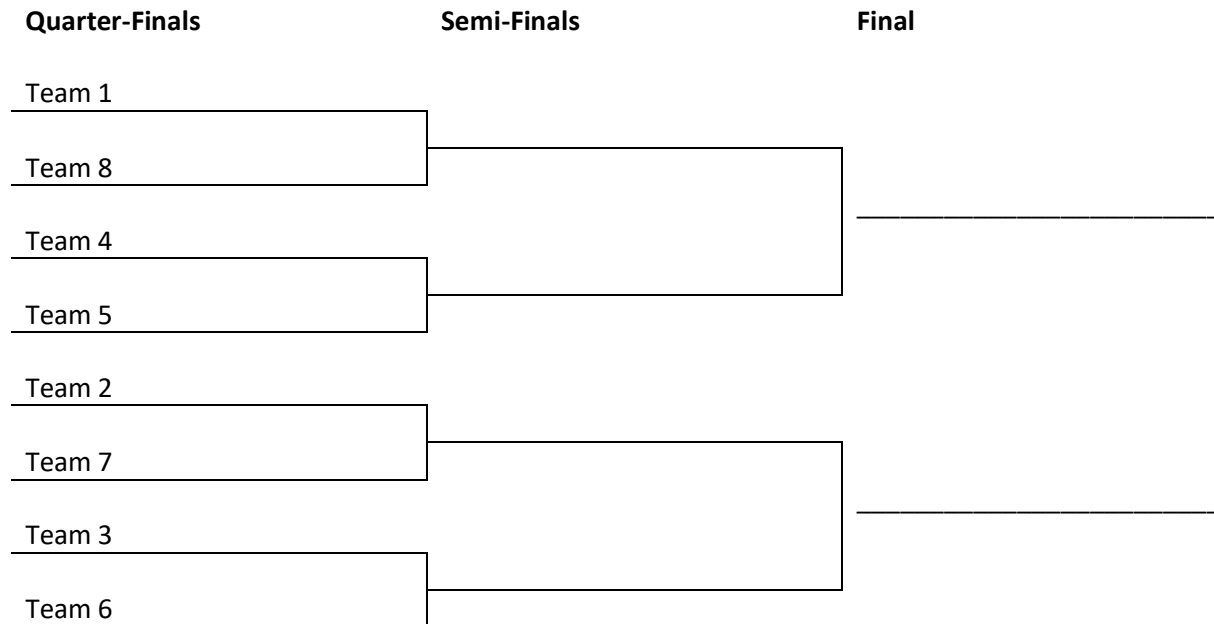
Advancement

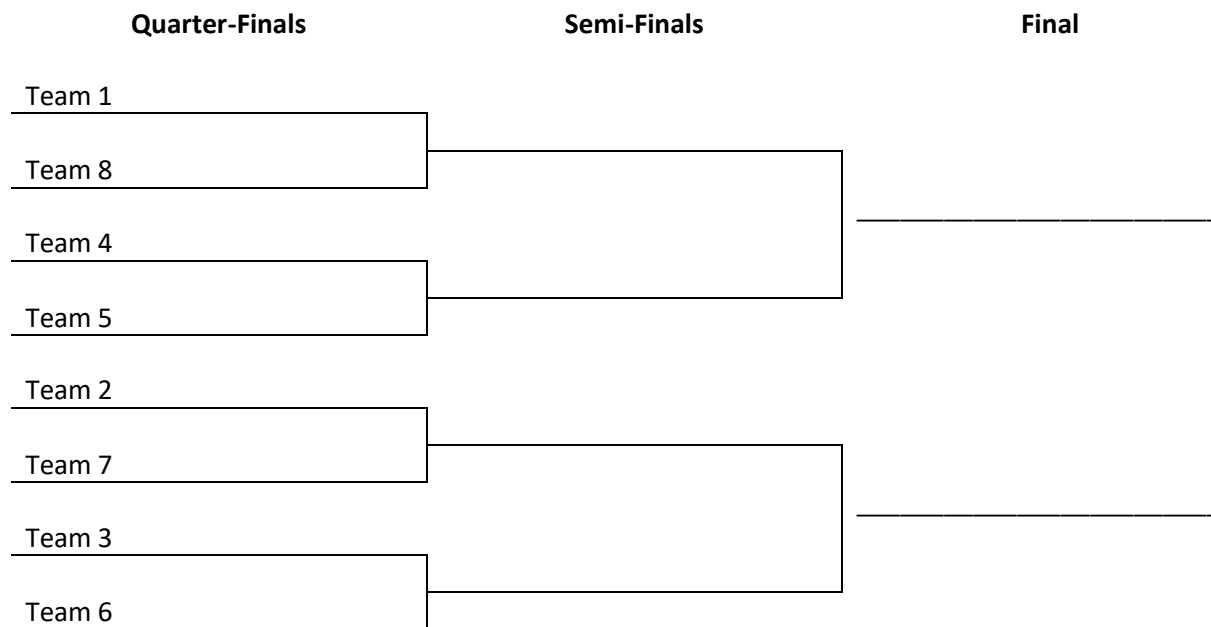
Advancement

There is no reseeding after Quarter-Finals. **Silver** will play Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals. For the Quarter-Finals, Teams 1 and 2 will receive a bye into the semi-finals and teams 3 through 6 will play. Quarter-finals will be seeded 3 v 6 (advancing to play 2 in the semi-finals) and 4 v 5 (advancing to play 1 in the semi-finals).

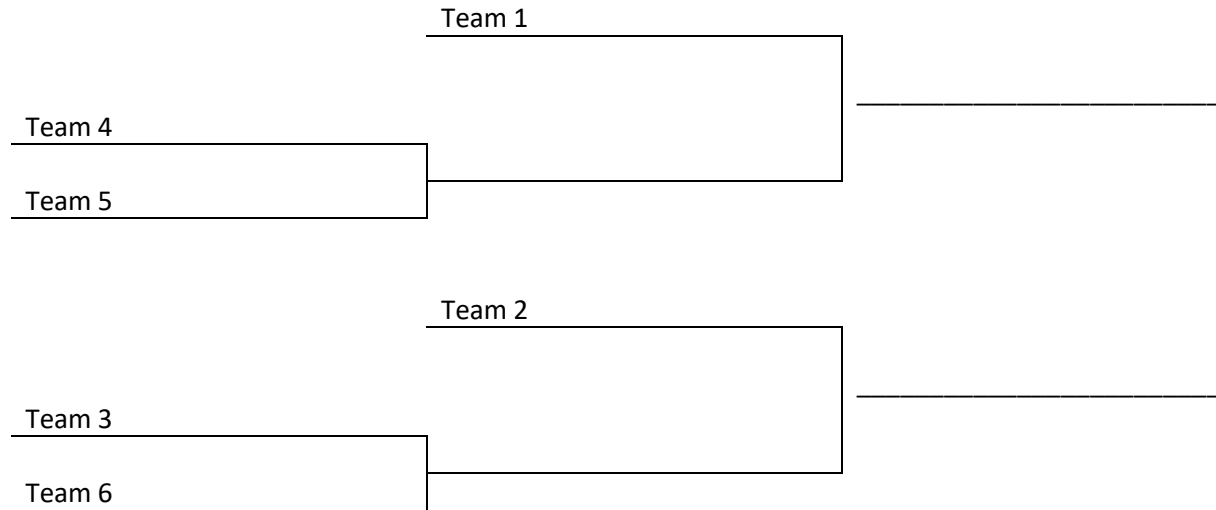

This age group will consist of 24 teams total and will be broken down into 6 groups of four. Each group will play each other within their group.

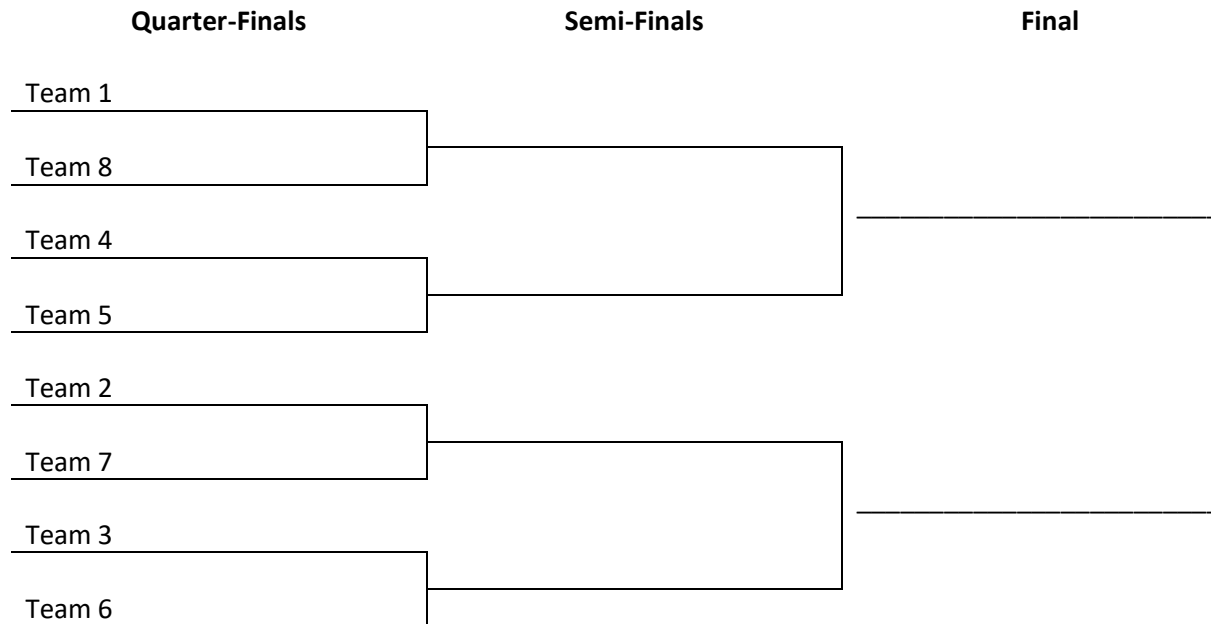
Advancement

This age group will consist of 30 teams total and will be broken down into 6 groups of four (A through F), and a group of 6 (G and H). Each group of 4 will play each other within their group, the group of 6 will play a modified cross-over bracket format (play each team in their group, then G #1 vs. H #3, G #2 vs. H2 #2, G #3 vs. H #1)

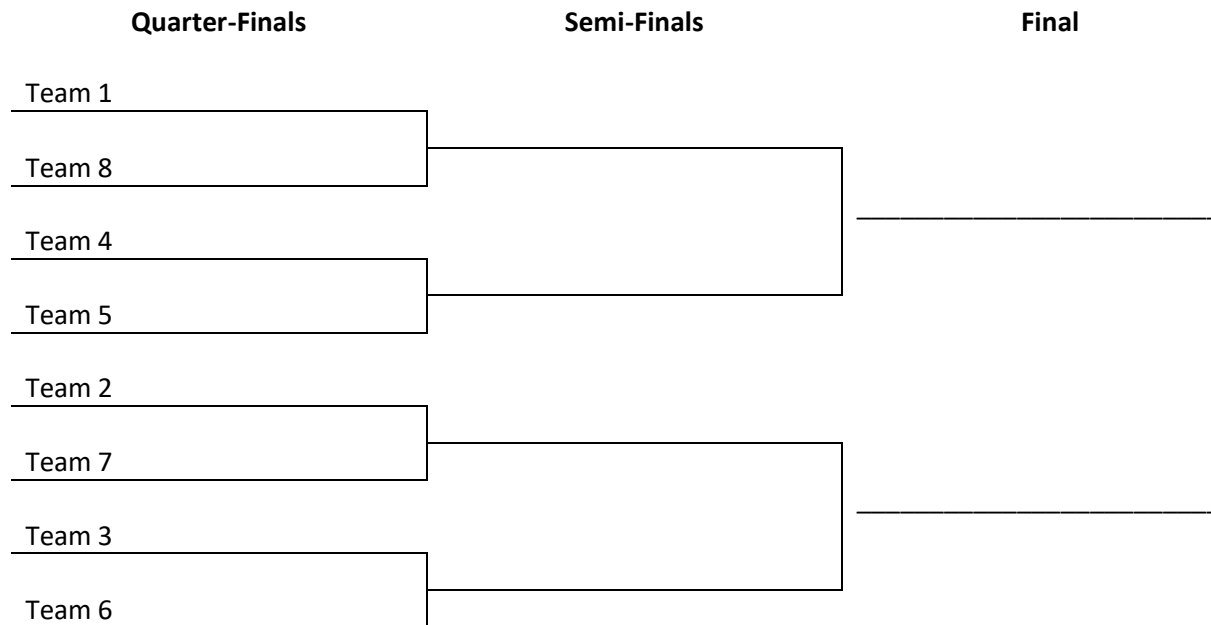
Advancement

This age group will advance to four groups: **SuperCopa**, consisting of the eight group winners following normal SuperCopa advancement protocols; **Gold**, consisting of the next eight highest ranking Wild Card teams; and **Silver**, consisting of the next eight highest ranking Wild Card Teams and **Bronze**, consisting of the next six highest ranking Wild Card teams.

Knock Out Rounds

SuperCopa, Gold, and Silver will play Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals. Quarter-Finals will be seeded 1 v 8, 2 v 7, 3 v 6, 4 v 5, following normal SuperCopa seeding protocols. There is no reseeding after Quarter-Finals. **Bronze** will play Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals. For the Quarter-Finals, Teams 1 and 2 will receive a bye into the semi-finals and teams 3 through 6 will play. Quarter-finals will be seeded 3 v 6 (advancing to play 2 in the semi-finals) and 4 v 5 (advancing to play 1 in the semi-finals).

Group Play

This group will consist of 10 teams total and will be broken down into 1 group of four (A), and a group of 6 (B and C). The group of 4 will play each other within their group, the group of 6 will play a modified cross-over bracket format (play each team in their group, then B #1 vs. C #3, B #2 vs. C #2, B #3 vs. C #1)

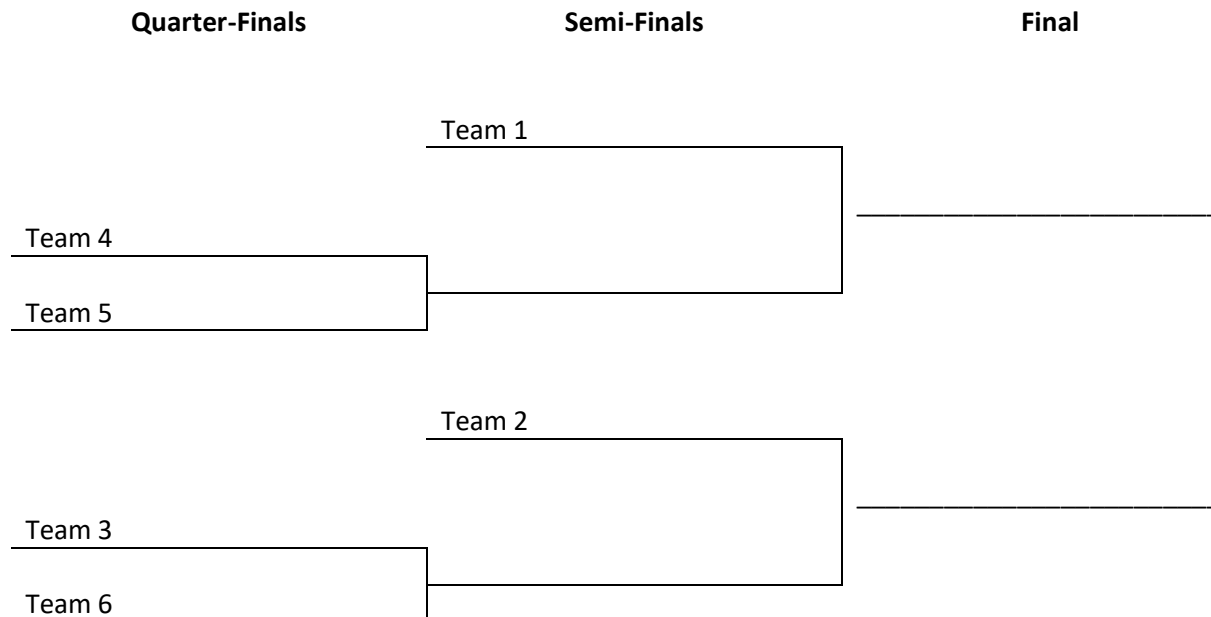
Advancement

This group will advance to two groups: **SuperCopa** consisting of the three group winners and the highest ranking three Wild Card teams, following normal SuperCopa advancement protocols; **Gold** consisting of the next four highest ranking Wild Card teams.

Knock Out Rounds

SuperCopa will play Quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals. For the Quarter-finals, Teams 1 and 2 will receive a bye into the semi-finals and teams 3 through 6 will play. Quarter-finals will be seeded 3 v 6 (advancing to play 2 in the semi-finals) and 4 v 5 (advancing to play 1 in the semi-finals); **Gold** will play semi-finals and finals. Semi-finals will be seeded 1 v 4 and 2 v 3, following normal SuperCopa seeding protocols.
